Students who entered Rowan University prior to Fall 2018 should follow the guide for their program and start year. Rowan University Graduation Requirements

- Students must complete at least 120 s.h. (semester hours) of coursework that applies to their Rowan University degree
- Students must have an overall/cum. G.P.A. of at least 2.0. (Only Rowan University courses count toward the G.P.A.)
- A minimum of 30 s.h. of coursework must be completed at/through Rowan University
- Only grades of "D-" or above may apply to graduation requirements (some programs may set higher minimums)
- Students must apply for graduation and should do so for the term in which they will complete all program requirements

Program-Specific Graduation & Certification Requirements

- Students must receive a grade of C- or better in all courses required for B.A. in SME
- Students MUST have an overall G.P.A. of at least 3.0 (Only Rowan University courses count toward the G.P.A.)
- All students must meet Guidelines for Determining Eligibility for Admission to subject-specific SME program: Admission to Clinical Practice and Completion of Program (i.e., Benchmark Requirements) see Guidelines for list of requirements
- Students must apply for graduation and teaching certification within the term in which all program requirements are complete
- All students must take and pass the Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators: Basic Skills Tests. See Required Graduation/Certification Tests on p. 3
- All students must take and pass the Praxis II in their teaching discipline: English (test code: 5038. See Required Graduation/Certification Tests on p.3
- All students must take and pass edTPA. See Required Graduation/Certification Tests on p. 3
