## Rowan University Graduation Requirements for all Majors / Degrees

- Students must complete at least 120 semester hours (sh) of coursework that apply to their Rowan University degree.
- Students must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 in Rowan University coursework. (Transfer courses/credit do not count toward the RU GPA.)
- A minimum of 30 sh of coursework must be completed at/through Rowan University.
- Only grades of "D-" or above may apply to graduation/degree requirements. (Some programs may set higher minimums.)
- Students must meet the Rowan Core and Rowan Experience Requirements.
- An individual course can potentially satisfy one Rowan Core literacy and/or multiple Rowan Experience attributes.
- Rowan Core \& Rowan Experience designations are listed in course details in Section Tally (https://sites rowan edu/registrar/services-resources/sec-tion-tally-info.htm! ) and may also be searched on that site under "Attributes." - Students must apply for graduation and should do so for the term in which they will complete all program requirements.
