

## CHAMP/GEAR UP Program 2025 Summer Mentor Application

CHAMP/GEAR UP is a pre-college program operated out of the Rowan University Camden Campus. The program consists of a six-week summer program, held on the Glassboro and Camden Campuses.

The summer program will run from June 23<sup>rd</sup>, thru August 1<sup>st</sup>, and consist of enrichment activities in Math, Writing, Computer Science, environmental and physical science, financial literacy, team building and group activities, along with educational field trips. The program's goal is to increase the student's in academic areas while increasing the college awareness. CHAMP/GEAR UP is a program for the students who want to go to college and are willing to experience a different kind of learning experience. If hired, all mentors will need to attend a one week training session which will take place on Monday, June 1<sup>th</sup> through Saturday, June 21st.

<b>JUNIOR CHAMP</b>
<b>COMPONENT</b>

Includes rising 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade students; Classes take place on the Rowan Camden campus. Mentors will work with students at the RUCAB and attend all field trips with the students.

## SENIOR CHAMP COMPONENT

Includes rising 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students; Classes take place on the Rowan Glassboro campus. Mentors will work with students on the Glassboro campus and attend all field trips with the students.

## RESIDENTIAL CHAMP COMPONENT

Includes rising 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> grade students; Students live in the dorms and take classes on the Glassboro campus. Mentors will work with students in class, facilitate workshops in the dorm and attend all field trips with the students.

#### **Counselor Eligibility**

CHAMP/GEAR UP is seeking to employ college students who will serve as mentor/tutor and role models for Camden City students. Mentors will interact with students in a classroom setting as well as chaperone field trips and free-time activities.

#### Mentors must be....

- 1). Currently enrolled in a college or university with a G.P.A of 2.5 or better
- 2). A good role models
- 3). Able to create and facilitate workshops
- 4). Available to attend a mandatory weeklong orientation, including possible overnight retreat, and work with the <u>entire</u> 6 weeks of the program.

A completed application accompanied by a <u>resume</u>, <u>current college transcript</u> and (2) <u>letters of recommendation</u> must be submitted to the CHAMP office by **March 1**, **2025**.
