Timeline:

The entire Title IX disciplinary process (excluding appeal) should take approximately 60 days. All of the timeframes may be extended by the Title IX Coordinator for good cause with written notice to both parties.

Title IX Coordinator receives report of sexual misconduct Title IX Coordinator offers services, options with complainant. Complainant or the University initiates formal Title IX process. Written notice of the charges sent to the Respondent and services offered. (Within 7 days of the complaint) Impartial and thorough investigation conducted: Witnesses interviewed/ evidence reviewed. (Approximately 45 Initial report with findings of facts sent to both parties. Parties have 7 days to review and provide rebuttal information. Investigator reviews additional information (if any) and draft final investigative report. Final report submitted to the Assistant Vice President of Civic Involvement. Adjudicatory Hearing (Within 20 days after final investigative report submitted) **Appeal Process**
