Glassware Disposal Box Guidelines

Glassware disposal boxes are for the collection of broken and non-broken laboratory glass and plasticware. Please see below for permitted and prohibited wastes and other important information.



Prohibited Waste Permitted Waste* • General Trash Laboratory glassware Syringes (With & Without a needle attached) Sharp/pointed laboratory plasticware that Needles Scalpels could poke through a trash bag. Example: Serological pipettes or pipette tips used Razor Blades only for chemical transfer. Glass/plasticware containing chemicals or biological/infectious substances Preserved or non-preserved animal or plant * IMPORTANT! materials. Waste must not be contaminated with any biological or infectious material. • Only residual/trace chemical contamination on waste items is permissible.

NEVER USE BROKEN GLASSWARE DISPOSAL BOXES FOR THE DISPOSAL OF CHEMICAL WASTE, REGULATED MEDICAL WASTE, OR ANY OTHER UNAPPROVED ITEMS OR SUBSTANCES!

Transport glassware disposal boxes to the building's loading dock when approximately 2/3 full. Contact Rowan Custodial Services at HouseKeeping@Rowan.edu to have boxes disposed of in the trash dumpster. Do not overfill broken glassware containers or allow them to become too heavy for a person to safely lift by hand.
