Description

As part of the Campbell Library Project, the Technology Assistance Center (TAC), the nexus of all in-person technology support on the Glassboro campus which houses and dispatches technicians across campus and handles the receiving and distribution of physical technology assets, is being moved from Memorial Hall to Campbell Library.

As such, it has been determined that it is in the best interest of the University to relocate the entire Division of Information Resources & Technology from Memorial Hall to the 4th floor of Campbell Library. Programming & Design are ongoing.

Additionally, it is anticipated that a Design Consultant may be needed for the Memorial Hall renovation work due to the complex phasing components of the various moves.
