Introducing the renovated Bunce Hall

This project consisted of the renovation and repurposing of Bunce Hall. Changing needs of the University have affected the way academic and administrative space has been organized. Over the years, the allocation and reallocation of space has resulted in several academic and administrative functions being separated and spread across the campus in various buildings.

The relocation of the College of Business from Bunce Hall to its new home and other space planning decisions over the recent past have caused a domino effect creating significant opportunities for more logical and efficient space allocation, adjacencies, consolidation, relocation and repurposing. These include upgrades to the space for College of Performing Arts, four to five multipurpose spaces on the second floor and renovation to the third floor to house executive offices.
