Rowan University is a Carnegie-classified national doctoral research institution dedicated to excellence in undergraduate education. Founded in 1923 in Glassboro, Rowan serves the public at nine campuses and 100+ education, clinical and research sites.

Rowan regularly earns notable national recognition. The historic \$100 million Rowan gift in 1992 put the institution on the fast track, helped create the Henry M. Rowan College of Engineering and enabled ambitious institutional growth. Now, with three medical schools and powerful partnerships in education, health care and research, Rowan provides transformational leadership in higher education.
