As the nation's third fastest-growing public research university, Rowan is home to a thriving multidisciplinary environment with a strong emphasis on practical research in health care, engineering, science and business.

Classified by the Carnegie Foundation as an R2 (high research activity) institution and rapidly heading to R1 (very high research activity), the University partners with industry, government and nonprofit organizations in New Jersey and beyond. Students are essential contributors, presenting at national conferences, sharing credit in professional publications and earning recognition for their work.

Rowan's partnerships with Virtua Health and Cooper University Health Care distinguish southern New Jersey as a hub for health care research and education.

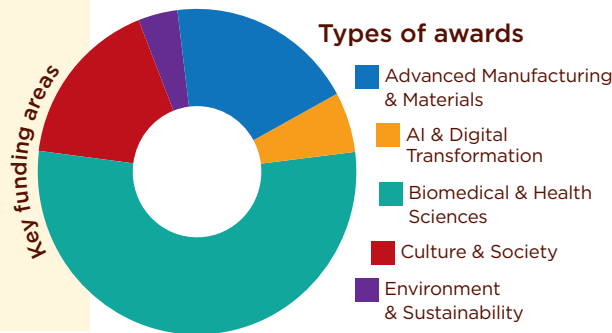

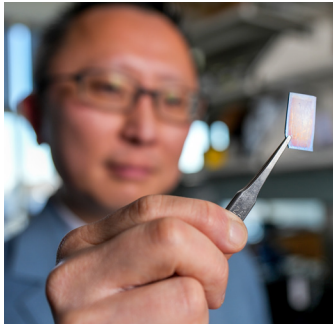

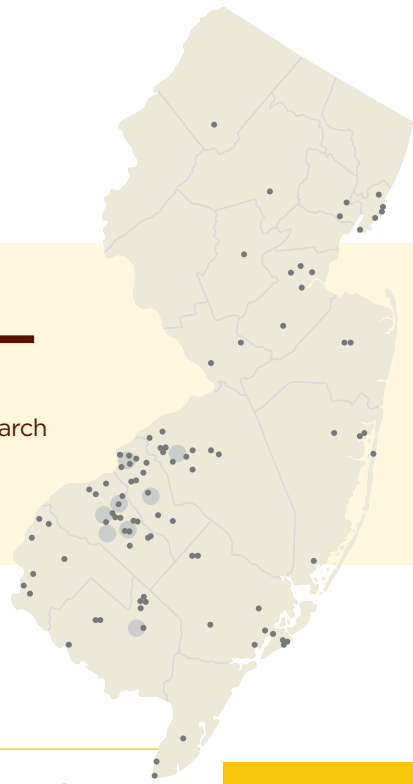
