Academic Program Guide for New First-Year Students Honors College

Rowan University Graduation Requirements for all Majors / Degrees

- Students must complete at least 120 semester hours (sh) of coursework that apply to their Rowan University degree.
- Students must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 in Rowan University coursework. (Transfer courses/credit do not count toward the RU GPA.)
- A minimum of 30 sh of coursework must be completed at/through Rowan University.
- Only grades of “D-” or above may apply to graduation/degree requirements. (Some programs may set higher minimums.)
- Students must meet the Rowan Core and Rowan Experience Requirements.
 - An individual course can potentially satisfy one Rowan Core literacy and/or multiple Rowan Experience attributes.
 - Rowan Core and Rowan Experience designations are listed in course details in Section Tally (www.rowan.edu/registrar) and may also be searched on that site under “Attributes.” A list of Rowan Core courses is here: <https://confluence.rowan.edu/display/AS/Rowan+Core+Course+List>.
- Students must apply for graduation and should do so for the term in which they will complete all program requirements.

Program-Specific Graduation Requirements for this Concentration

- Students must have a cumulative GPA of at least **3.5** in Rowan University coursework.

Rowan Core Requirements

Students must satisfy all six Rowan Core Literacies. A minimum total of 3 sh of coursework is required to satisfy each Literacy.

With the exception of the 9 sh counted here for Communicative Literacy, credits attached to the courses in this section will apply elsewhere.

- (COML) Communicative Literacy: Honors students must fulfill their communication literacy in **Honors sections** of these three courses:
- COMP 01111 College Composition I (3 sh) ○ COMP 01112 College Composition II (3 sh) ○ CMS 04205 Public Speaking (3 sh)
- (ARTL) Artistic Literacy ○ (GLBL) Global Literacy ○ (HUML) Humanistic Literacy
- (QNTL) Quantitative Literacy ○ (SCL) Scientific Literacy

- Students are required to enroll in CCI, CCII, and PS unless they have placed out of the course, have transferred the credit prior to matriculation, or have received permission from the Honors Advisor or the Assistant Dean to enroll in another section. Students will then have to take additional Honors designated courses.
- Engineering Majors need 3 additional courses, all other majors need 5 additional honors designated courses
- Honors classes are prorated so internal/external transfer students and those graduating early are not penalized; the total is calculated at a rate of 2 honors designated courses per academic year or 1 per semester
