

Townhouse Move-In Process

Move-in Schedule:

Townhouse Move-in is scheduled for Sunday, September 1st between at 8 AM and 4 PM.

Parking & Unloading:

1] Enter campus at the main Welcome Gate off of Mullica Hill Rd. directly across from Savitz Hall and the statue of Henry Rowan.

2] You will be directed through the drive-up check-in line by Public Safety Officers. Check-in will be curbside on Townhouse Dr. just before the Townhouse Parking Garage.

- You may only bring one vehicle to your unloading area.

3] At this point, your appointment time and move-in eligibility will be confirmed.

- Any student with an administrative hold as per the Dean of Students Office will not be permitted to receive your apartment key or move your belongings in.

4] Once your move-in eligibility is confirmed, you will be directed to your specified unloading area.

- Residents in building 1 – 6 will park in Lots G or Z-1 behind Hawthorn or Bozorth Hall.
- Residents in building 7 – 17 will continue to the ground floor of the parking garage.
- A limited supply of push carts will be available for you to sign out by staff to assist with your unloading.
- Once your vehicle is unloaded, return the carts to staff and move your vehicle to the upper floors of the garage.
- You must complete your move and re-locate your vehicle as soon as possible. This allows students in the next appointment time to access the garage and carts.

A limited number of push carts as well as motorized carts operated by Rowan Facilities personnel will be on hand to assist with your moving process. However, if you have access to a dolly or hand truck, it is recommended that you bring it.

Other Important Information and Reminders:

Your Rowan ID Card- If you do not have your ID or it is damaged, you should report to the Student Center to get a new ID made. They have hours of operation during the day throughout move-in weekend.

Vaccination Requirements- You must have all vaccination paperwork in to Health Services – See Health Services with any additional questions (856-256-4333) or online. **Any student who does not have an up-to-date immunization record on file with the University Wellness Center will not be permitted to check in.**
