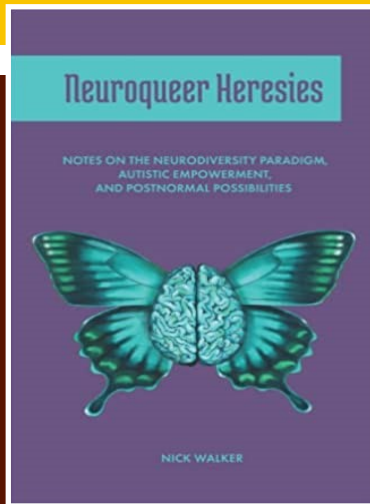


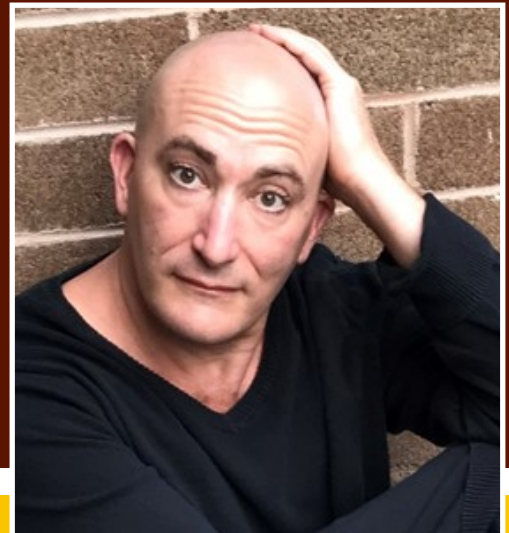
# NEURODIVERSITY AND INTERSECTIONALITY: A Virtual Series Talk with *DR. NICK WALKER*
