



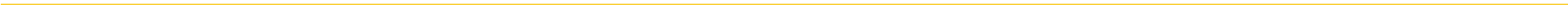

# Quick Look

- 19,465 students enrolled
  - SAT for regular admit freshmen is 1279
  - Faculty/Student Ratio: 1:17
  - Avg. undergraduate class size: 21
  - Students taking online classes (at least one online class): 6,230
  - We've hired 142 new faculty this year

  - Athletics complex on West Campus
  - New academic building on Rt. 322, near power plant

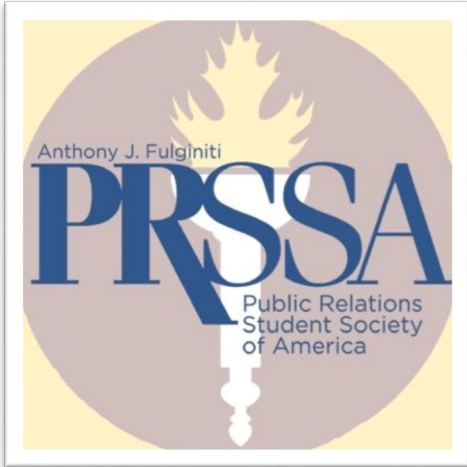
