



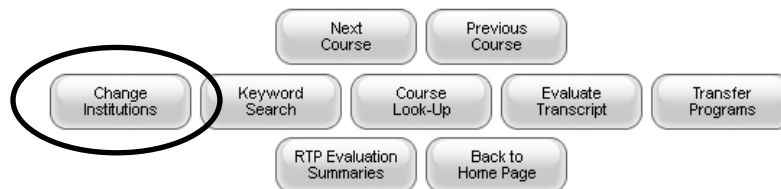

 - (BIO 01076 – GE Biology Lab Science Elective 1 crds.)
- The two courses combined together will meet Rowan’s equivalent
 - (BIOL 01100 – Biology I 4 crds.)
