SOM operates under the semester system with two semesters (Fall and Spring) each academic year. The curriculum is a required course load described by the faculty with no substitutions. All students attend full-time, and credits/credit hours are not calculated.

Course Numbering System

A three to four character alphabetic Subject Code represents the department. This is followed by a 5-character alphanumeric group. In this group, the first digit indicates the level of the course (6 for first-year, 7 for second-year, 8 for third-year and 9 for fourth-year). The last three digits are the course number and the letter represents the school.
