Terms and Semester Hours

Rowan-Virtua School of Osteopathic Medicine (RV-SOM) operates under the semester system and clock hours. The curriculum is a required course load determined by the faculty with no substitutions and all students attend full-time. RV-SOM does not calculate GPA, quality points, or credits/credit hours.

Course Numbering System

An alphabetic Subject code represents the department. This is followed by a 5-character alphanumeric group. In this group, the first digit indicates the level of the course (6 for first-year, 7 for second-year, 8 for third-year and 9 for fourth-year). The last three digits are the course number and the letter represents the school.
