Terms and Semester Hours

The TBES [formerly the GSBS] operates under the semester system with three semesters (Fall, Spring and Summer) each academic year. The curriculum is defined by the individual program of study. Students may attend as full-time or part-time.

Course Numbering System

Rowan University (July 2013 to present): A three-character alphabetic Subject Code represents the program. This is followed by a 5-character numeric group. In this group, the first two digits typically are 00 followed by the three digit course number. The three-digit course number indicates the level of the course (5 and 6 for Masters-level courses, 7 for Doctoral-level foundation courses, 8 for Doctoral-level courses and 9 for Doctoral-level research courses).

Formerly UMDNJ (Prior to July 2013): A three to four character alphabetic Subject Code represents the department. This is followed by a 5-character alphanumeric group. In this group, the first digit indicates the level of the course (5 for graduate-level). The last three digits are the course number and the letter represents the school.
