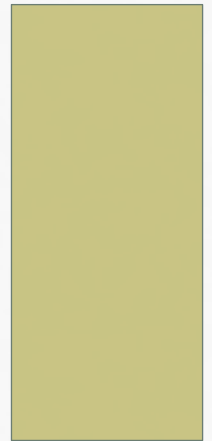


ORIENTATION FOR NEW SENATORS

Duties of the Senate

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- It also proposes modifies, and reviews academic procedures...
- ...and oversees the administration of personnel policies negotiated by the AFT.

The members of the Senate

- The Senate consists of representatives from the faculty, professional staff, athletics, and library staff represented by the AFT bargaining unit.

Organization of the Senate

- Senate officers: a president, vice-president, and secretary are elected yearly. A parliamentarian is appointed by the President, with the advice and consent of the Senate.

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- There are also six All University Committees.
- Senate meetings are once monthly, during the open period.

Responsibilities of Senators

- Appoint an alternate from your department or area and notify Liz Ramos (ramos@rowan.edu) of their name.

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- Sign in (or have your alternate sign in) at each in-person meeting.
- Chair or serve on at least one Senate committee.

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- Deliver reports on Senate proceedings to your department or area.
- Report any issues or concerns from your constituents to the Senate. You can present these at Senate meetings, or to Senate President Bill Freind, freind@rowan.edu, x6-3489.
- Remember that your votes should reflect the consensus of your constituents.
