In the Table of Contents, all entries must be worded exactly as they appear in the body text, and all important words must be capitalized. Even Level 3 headings, which will appear uncapitalized in the text, must be capitalized in the Table of Contents.

In scientific theses/dissertations, students can choose to number their headings, or to leave them unnumbered. This choice must be consistent between the Table of Contents and the body content.

* These headings are incorrect. The dot leader must be connected to both a word and a page number. If necessary, you may move the final word of a heading down to the next line to connect the dot leader correctly. There should always be a clear dot leader between the final word and the page number.

Headings with long titles must also be single-spaced.

In science documents, you may choose to number your figures either consecutively or according to the chapter in which they appear.

Figure and table titles must be short and descriptive. They should not take up more than two lines.

How to Indent Figure Captions

Figure captions longer than one line must be indented so that the first word of each new line lines up with the first word of the previous line.

To do this, you will press Enter at the end of the first line, place your cursor before the first word on the second line, and use the top “First Line Indent” tab on the ruler at the top of the screen to move the second line into the correct, indented position.

In science documents, you may choose to number your tables either consecutively or according to the chapter in which they appear.


