<p>Program graduates will have the knowledge and skills about wellness and nutrition to promote evidence-based health services as a competent entry-level dietitian.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Of graduates who seek employment, at least 80 percent are employed in nutrition and dietetics or related fields within 12 months of graduation. • At least 80 percent of program graduates take the CDR credentialing exam for dietitian nutritionists within 12 months of program completion. • Of employers who hire CPD program graduates, at least 80 percent of employers agree that their new CPD hire was adequately prepared for entry-level practice. • Within a year of completion, 80% of CPD graduates note that program prepared them for competence as entry-level nutrition practitioners.
<p>Program graduates will be prepared for competent entry-level nutrition practices and services that are culturally appropriate for individuals and groups in various practice settings.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At least 80% of program graduates take the CDR credentialing exam for dietitian nutritionists within 12 months of program completion. • The program's one-year pass rate (graduates who pass the registration exam within one year of first attempt) on the CDR credentialing exam for dietitian nutritionists is at least 80%. • Of employers who hire CPD program graduates, at least 80% of employers agree that their new CPD hire was adequately prepared for entry-level practice. • Within a year of completion, 80% of CPD graduates note that program prepared them for competence as entry-level nutrition practitioners.
