## **About the Earn and Learn Program**

- All classes in the Construction Management program are fully online and run asynchronously (no zoom or webex meetings)
- Structured by week: Classes start on a Tuesday and the week runs through the following Monday
- Classes run in 8 modules
- Discussion Questions are due Friday nights and assignments and quizzes are due Monday nights
- Courses require approximately 3-5 hours of work a week
- Add/drop is 10/29 11/4; late add/drop is 11/5 11/11

(Add/drop = the period during which you can add or drop classes if taking multiple courses)



### Four tips for a successful academic experience



### **Get organized**

- Review your course syllabus and assignment deadlines
- Plan for your online classes in your weekly schedule
- Log into MyRowan at the start of your day



### **Communicate often**

- Check your email to ensure that you are aware of deadlines
- Talk to your professors and make use of office hours
- If you run into trouble, reach out as soon as possible



### Find support

- Start a study group with members of your union
- Talk to family, friends, or colleagues about how to balance your workload
- Make use of Rowan's online resources, such as Rowan Online Immersion

 Keep your goal in mind; every successful class puts you one step closer to achieving your goals





Account Set Up--NetID





## Our suggestions for success in the program
