



## IMPORTANT PUBLIC NOTICE

### NEW ORDINANCE - PARKING BY PERMIT IN DESIGNATED AREAS

**If you have received this notification, the area in which you reside has been designated a Parking by Permit zone.**

#### ***Start Date***

Starting on Labor Day and ending Memorial Day all vehicles within the designated zones will require a parking permit, please reference to Borough Ordinance Chapter 445-57

#### ***Two Types of Permits***

Residents within the designated zones will be provided resident parking permits and guest parking permits.

#### ***Example***

You have three cars housed at your home, but can only fit two in the driveway. Your house will receive one resident permit and in any situation three guest permits.

#### ***If Additional Parking is Required***

If additional parking is required for an event or function contact Gloucester County Communications Center at 856.881.1500 for authorization.

#### ***Specifics***

- Permits for rental properties **will** be valid for one year, July 1 – June 30 and will vary in color each year.
- Permits for owner-occupied homes will be white, and will **not** be required to be renewed annually.
- Permits will be a hang tag design, facing outward, utilizing the vehicles rear view mirror.
- Initial permits will be free, if lost or stolen replacement permits may be acquired at the Borough Code - Zoning Office at a cost of \$30.
- Permits are to be used for day parking only between the hours of 6:00 am - 2:00 am

#### ***Issuance***

Residents are directed to call the Code - Zoning Office at 856-881-9230 ext. 88311 to obtain permits.

#### ***Reminder of Overnight Parking***

Borough Ordinance 445-14 (G), **all vehicles including Permit Parking Only are not permitted** to park on the street overnight between 2:00 am and 6:00 am without contacting Gloucester County Communications Center at 856.881.1500 for authorization
